

MCM supply and deliver fully compliant BS3882 topsoil. Because of the processes and components used in their manufacture, handling and storage, MCM can demonstrate that our soil products are contaminant-free. We are unable to control and be held responsible for what happens to the material once it leaves its delivery vehicle, i.e. once it is tipped and placed on site.

UKAS-approved Testing: Subsequent Collection and Replacement

Immediately after leaving our delivery vehicle, any subsequent machinery intervention, ground condition or material contact on site may constitute a potential risk of contamination for which we cannot be held accountable.

For this reason, MCM will only commit to collecting and replacing topsoil that has failed testing by a reputable UKAS-approved laboratory and then, only if the following procedure has been adhered to prior to its testing:

- We are made aware that testing will be taking place prior to delivery.
- Sampling must be taken from the tipped load immediately after the soil has left the lorry and preferably from the top of the pile.
- Sample must be split and a signed bag given to an MCM representative or the driver of the lorry.

These caveats are in place to protect both us as Supplier as well as you the Contractor.
